This introduction to the foundations of Catholic health ministry will help leaders to more effectively carry out their responsibilities as organizational leaders.

Participants who complete *Foundations of Catholic Healthcare Leadership* will be able to:

- Describe the roots of Catholic healthcare
- Articulate the relationships among Church, sponsor, and organization
- Relate one's personal values to his or her organizational commitment
- For selected ethical issues, explain Church teaching as presented in the *Ethical and Religious Directives for Catholic Health Care Services*
- Identify one's approach to ethical decision making
- Apply the professional values and obligations associated with the role of leadership in healthcare – and the fundamental social values underlying Catholic healthcare services – to management issues

The *Foundations of Catholic Healthcare Leadership* course is designed by members of the Catholic Health Association of the United States (CHA). ACE Level II credits are available for participation in this program.

A Real World Focus

This two-day program consists of integrated, interactive presentations and activities that address three areas of leadership with information, experiential opportunities, dialogue, reflection, and other resources for learning. The presenters focus on the “real world” impact of the theological, ethical and sponsorship concepts addressed.
